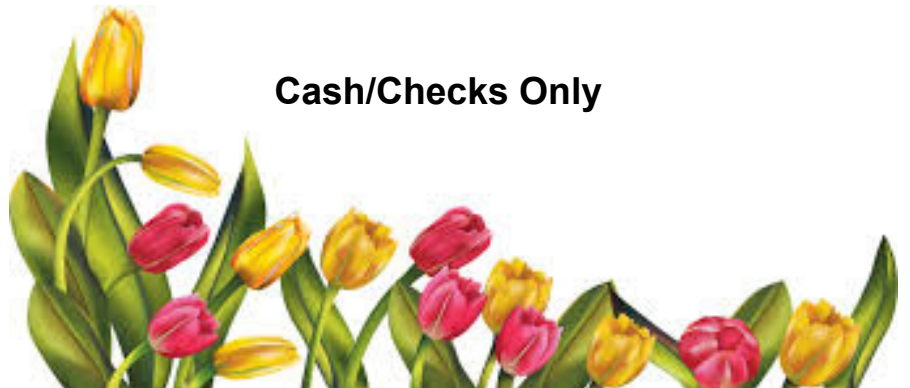

The primary revenue stream for the Friends of the Library continues to be SALES of Donated Books from Patrons and Friends. Through the efforts of many, many, many volunteers, the combined total sales generates over \$60,000 per year.
